The May 18, 2023 meeting minutes were approved.

Agenda Items:

1. Speeding on Rosedale Avenue

Several options to address speeding on Rosedale were discussed including:

- Changing all of Rosedale to a one-way street
- Changing Rosedale to a one-way street beginning at Merrill Street and heading south
- Installing stop signs, specifically a 4-way stop sign on Ravensdale and Rosedale

A suggestion was made to refer to the recent Village traffic study for guidance.

In addition to speeding, parking on Rosedale was discussed at length. Currently parking is permitted on both sides of the street. However, Rosedale is a narrow street and there is concern about emergency vehicle access - especially when school is in session and there are many cars parked. The option of changing the rules so that only one side of Rosedale would have parking was suggested.

PD continues to monitor and ticket cars that are illegally parked on Rosedale.

2. Handicap Parking Spots on Maple Avenue near North Street

Resident Mary Fennel contacted the Safety Council regarding increasing the number of handicapped spots in this location. Chief Dosin will investigate and take pictures in the area in front of 57 Maple Avenue – the Northwest corner of the Rivers Edge Apartments for review at the next Safety Council meeting.

New Business:

Areas where brush is overgrown and must be cut back were identified:

- Forest Ave & Hollywood
- Hollywood & Floral
- Ravensdale & Rosedale across from Dan Rile Park
- Corner of Farragut & Ravensdale

The next Safety Council meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 19, 2023 @7PM.
