The November 17, 2023 meeting minutes were approved.

Agenda Items:

1. Traffic in front of Westchester Manor – 140 Saw Mill River Road

There was a suggestion from a resident to put a crosswalk in front of Westchester Manor to allow for safer pedestrian crossings over the busy road. Saw Mill River Road is a state road and the Village does not have the authority to make changes to it.

There was also discussion about whether a crosswalk could be installed in the middle of a road versus the regular spot – a corner. Modifications to the curbs (curb cuts) would have to be made when a crosswalk is installed.

The Council recommends Westchester Manor contact the state directly to see if a crosswalk could be installed.

2. Intersection of Broadway & Windsor

There was a suggestion from a resident for a crosswalk painted across Broadway just north of Windsor Rd before the turnaround to go south on Broadway which would span across both North and South Broadway. The crosswalk would allow for a safer crossing of Broadway on the way to the aqueduct trail.

This is a state road, and the Village does not have the authority to make changes to it. It was noted there were no sidewalks on either side of Broadway in that location.

Old Business

Review of stop signs at Broadway & Olinda – There are ongoing discussions about this.

Additional:

Safety Council will follow up with DPW on status of handicap spots on Maple Avenue

David Skolnik suggested the Safety Council encourage residents to read up on the Route 9 Complete Streets program.
