1. Solarize- application was submitted for Hastings and Dobbs Ferry to be a Solarize Westchester community. (More information at www.solarizewestchester.org). More information will be made available once we hear about the outcome of our application.
2. Complete Streets - Hastings will host a training with Nadine Lemons, of Tri-State Transportation Campaign. The meeting will be held in October, 2015 and include other Rivertown municipalities. We will look to collaborate together on Complete Street projects.
3. Waste - We are compiling and reviewing historical waste data for further action.
4. Sustainable Westchester - no update at this time.
5. Vine squad/Nature walks- the Committee will continue to work successfully with the Village's Recreation Department to promote Nature Walks to the broader community. We would also support a group to improve local trails.
6. Other topics:
 - a. Street lights- the Committee supports the full conversion to LED street lights with attention to the lumens/lighting needs of different areas of the Village.
 - b. The Bridge- As residents, the CC members support all efforts to maintain the view from the bridge within County requirements. The CC will not take a position on the fencing issue. We determined that it was not within our mandate.
 - c. Minutes. The CC will adopt formal Minutes of its meetings.
