Meeting Summary:

Chief Visalli and Manager Frobel discussed challenges and opportunities for improved traffic and pedestrian safety.

Chief Visalli informed us that “Slow Down Irvington” will become a quad-village Slow Down Rivertowns program, which was applauded by the group.

The importance of both driver and pedestrian education were stressed by the Committee and the Manager and Chief.

The Chief and Manager will provide pertinent accident/call data for our study and mapping. Committee discussed need to capture safety as well as perceived safety.

Discussed proposals for group name and mission statement. Will send to other members for consideration/editing.

Two members of the public voiced speeding and crossing concerns on Maple and Warburton Streets, respectively.

Decided to summarize Comprehensive Plan next meeting.

Meeting concluded with Victor Waldron showing us photos of proper crossing signage. Committee expressed consensus that improving existing crosswalks is a good initial proposal to bring to BOT.
