THURSDAY PICKUP - PAPER

Newspapers
Glossy Inserts
Phone Books
Magazines
Office Paper / Junk Mail
Brown Paper Bags
Corrugated Cardboard
Cereal & Pasta Boxes
Paperback Books

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- * waxed cardboard such as milk or OJ cartons
- * plastic or styrofoam packing materials
- * cardboard with any trace of food
- * hardcover books



REMEMBER:

ALL BINS & BUNDLES PUT TO CURB MUST NOT EXCEED 50 LBS.

FRIDAY PICKUP - COMMINGLED

METAL

Food & Beverage Cans
Clean Aluminum Foil / Aluminum Trays
Empty Aerosol Cans

GLASS

Glass Jars/Bottles

PLASTIC (Coded 1 thru 7)

Food Containers
Beverage Containers
Detergent Bottles
Household Cleaner & Shampoo Bottles
Coded Pails/Buckets
Coded Flower Pots/Trays

NON-RECYCLABLE:

- * toys, plastic bags, plastic film or styrofoam, regardless of code
- * light bulbs, drinking glasses, crystal, window or mirror glass, ceramicware
- * kitchen cookware, aluminum siding, scrap metal, appliances, pipes, wire hangers, paint cans or any containers that held potentially hazardous materials, such as pesticides, glues, solvents

SPECIAL HANDLING

BULK PICKUP

Furniture, Mattresses, Scrap Metal, Wire, Pipes, Motors, Sheet Metal, Appliances, Auto Parts are picked up by appointment only. **Not Picked Up:** Tires, Construction Debris, Bricks, Concrete, Stones, Soil.

YARD WASTE

DPW will pick up brush, yard waste, leaves on a regular schedule. Please check calendar.

CLOTHING & TEXTILES

Please bring to blue bins at DPW yard located at 69 Southside Avenue.

ELECTRONICS PICK UP

1st Wednesday of each month by appointment.

PAINT CANS

Need to dry out paint cans with cat litter before calling to schedule them for pickup.

CARPETING

Will be picked up by appointment only and must be bundled in 4 ft. lengths, tied or taped and weigh no more than 50 lbs. each.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

(Including car batteries, rechargeable batteries, and fluorescent light bulbs)
