Feedback from BoT on TWG Traffic Calming Proposals for Ravensdale and Warburton

Take out rumble strips proposal from both. Prioritize to-do's: Richard will do this, we discussed:

- Warburton: these recommendations are for the village to guide the county, who is re-paving the street: striping, new stop sign and crosswalk on Pinecrest
- Ravensdale: have engineer explore possibility of additional stop signs

Ravensdale Engineer Proposal

We heard from Mary that money may have been awarded for Ravensdale engineer consulting in the new budget. Jeanette to check on this.

Neighborhood Liaison Map

Dan presented a map of where the liaisons live.

Liaisons are Hastings residents who volunteered through the TWG and PTSA joint survey effort. They will serve as a local point of contact for neighborhood input on village traffic calming efforts.

Data Mapping

Reviewed data from village Chief of Police Chief Visalli (data for 2015 and 2016) and from TWG's village-wide resident survey. Data was presented by village resident and volunteer TWG research consultant Matt Cohen. Data reviewed included the number and location of accidents, and locations where residents responded they wanted sidewalks, stop signs and crosswalks.

Conservation Committee Liaison

Kerry-Jane King was appointed by the Conservation Committee to be new TWG liaison, to replace Andrew Ratzkin.

Comprehensive Plan Update

As Plan is being updated, we discussed how to get our data included.
