

RESOLUTIONS - BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING OF OCTOBER 15, 2019

84:19 ADOPTION OF PROPOSED LOCAL LAW J OF 2019

RESOLVED: that the Mayor and Board of Trustees hereby adopt Proposed Local Law J of 2019 to amend Chapter 292 Vehicles and Traffic with respect to Commercial Traffic restrictions, which upon enactment shall become Local Law #__ of 2019.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 282-28, Definitions, of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended as follows:

§ 282-28 Definitions.

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

BUS

Every motor vehicle designated for carrying more than 10 passengers and used for the transportation of persons, and every motor vehicle, other than a taxicab, designed and used for the transportation of persons for compensation.

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE

Every vehicle or combination of vehicles (including trucks, tractors, semitrailers and trailers), that is designed, used, or maintained primarily for the transportation of goods or property for commercial purposes.

PARKING or PARKED

The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise, property or passengers.

SCHOOL BUS

Every motor vehicle owned either by a public governmental agency or private school operated for the transportation of pupils, teachers and other persons acting in a supervisory capacity to or from school or school activities, or privately owned or operated for compensation for the transportation of pupils, teachers and other persons acting in a supervisory capacity to or from school or school activities.

SEMITRAILER

Any trailer which is so designed that when operated the forward end of its body or chassis rests upon the body or chassis of the towing vehicle.

TRACTOR

A motor vehicle designed and used for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn.

TRAILER

Any vehicle not propelled by its own power drawn on the public highways by a motor vehicle, except cycle sidecars, vehicles being towed by a nonrigid support and vehicles designed and primarily used for other purposes and only occasionally drawn by such a motor vehicle.

TRUCK

Any vehicle or combination of vehicles designed for the transportation of property that has the following characteristics:

- two axles and six tires, or
- three or more axles.

SECTION 2. Section 282-30, Use of street by heavy vehicles restricted, of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended as follows:

§ 282-30 Use of street by commercial vehicles restricted.

No commercial vehicles shall be permitted on the following streets in the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, except for the purpose of repairs, delivery or service to the residents of such streets:

Maple Avenue	Between Spring Street and North Street
North Street	Between Maple Avenue and Warburton Avenue
Olinda Avenue	Between Farragut Avenue and Broadway
Washington Avenue	Between Southside Avenue and Broadway
James Street	Between High Street and Tompkins Avenue
High Street	Between Broadway and Farragut Parkway
Pinecrest Drive	Between Warburton Avenue and Broadway

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

85:19 ADOPTION OF PROPOSED LOCAL LAW K OF 2019

RESOLVED: that the Mayor and Board of Trustees hereby adopt Proposed Local Law K of 2019 to amend Chapter 292 Vehicles and Traffic with respect to Loading Zones, which upon enactment shall become Local Law #__ of 2019.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 282-21, Loading zones; parking in front of driveways and access roads, of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended as follows:

§282-21

- A. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials, in any place marked as a loading zone during the hours between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, unless otherwise provided in this Article. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed 30 minutes.
- B. Loading zones are designated as follows:
 - (1) The east side of Warburton Avenue starting at a point 265 feet south of Villard Avenue, and extending for 45 feet south of that point.
 - (2) The west side of Warburton Avenue starting at a point approximately 42 feet south of West Main Street and extending south for approximately 45 feet from that point.
 - (3) The south side of Washington Avenue starting at a point 75 feet east of Southside Avenue and extending for 43 feet east of that point.
 - (4) The east side of Warburton Avenue starting at a point 241 feet southeast of the corner of Division Street and extending for 55 feet south of the southern edge of the existing driveway.
 - (5) The east side of Southside Avenue, starting at the corner of Spring Street and extending for 50 feet south of that point.
 - (6) The west side of Warburton Avenue, directly in front of 577 Warburton Avenue, for a length of 20 feet.
 - (7) The north side of Spring Street, 110 feet west of Warburton Avenue, for a length of 20 feet east.
 - (8) At Steinschneider Plaza Parking Lot from Hastings Prime Meats north to the Hastings Laundromat (15 minutes only).
 - (9) A five-minute loading zone on the south side of Washington Avenue, from the intersection of Ridge Street for a distance of 40 feet going east.
- C. Parking in front of driveways and access roads. Parking in front of any driveway or access road which prevents free entry and egress to any public or private building, garage, park or public place is prohibited.

- D. When responding to an emergency, firefighters of the Protection Engine Company #1 may park at the marked loading zones identified in Section 282-21B(1) and (6) above for the duration of the emergency call.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
