

## PROPOSED LOCAL LAW J OF 2021

### A LOCAL LAW Amending Chapter 282, Vehicles and Traffic of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, Immobilization of Vehicles to Require Payment of Penalties

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 282, Vehicles and Traffic, Article XVII Immobilization of Vehicles, Section 282-50 Release of vehicle to owner, Subsection A is amended to read as follows:

§282-50.A. Any immobilized vehicle, as herein provided, shall be released to its owner upon payment of the expenses of immobilization and all outstanding parking fines and penalties against the immobilized vehicle. A vehicle release must be obtained from the Village Justice Court during normal business hours. Once the release is obtained from the Village Justice Court, it may be presented to the Police Department, during normal business hours, in order to have the Police Department remove the immobilization device or release the vehicle from impound.

### **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY**

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

### **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
