Applying for a Plumbing or Electrical Permit

The licensed plumbing or electrical contractor applies for a plumbing or electrical permit online at www.epropertyportal.com. If they have never used the system before, they will need to register with an email and a password. By answering all the questions asked in the portal, the permit application will be created.

The application is then ready to be submitted online. Once submitted, the contractor must then <u>print</u> the application, sign it, and either mail it to the Building Department or bring it into the Building Department, along with:

- 1. Certificate of liability insurance naming the Village* as additionally insured.
- 2. Proof of workers' compensation on the C-105 or equivalent form. We do not accept it on the Accord form.
- 3. A copy of their current Westchester County master plumber or master electrician license.
- 4. Payment

The fee for an electrical permit is \$100, unless it is documenting previously completed work (a legalization), then it would be double fees or \$200. There will be an additional \$50 inspection fee for low voltage fire alarms.

The fee for a plumbing permit is \$100, plus \$50 per inspection, unless it is documenting previously-completed work (a legalization), then it would be \$300.
