Hastings Day Camp 2019

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Welcome to Hastings Day Camp 2019! We are all very excited about the upcoming camp season! We wanted to inform you which group your child will be joining this season. Camp will take place at <u>Hillside Elementary School</u>. It begins July 1<sup>st</sup> and runs through August 9<sup>th</sup> (just a reminder there will be NO camp on Thursday July 4<sup>th</sup>).

Camp starts daily at 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm. Any late campers should report directly to the Camp Office with a parent or guardian. Daily drop-off and pick-up will take place on the field. Campers should report directly to their group spot on the field and say hello to their counselors. The circle at Hillside Elementary School is a fire lane, therefore no parking or leaving of a vehicle is permitted at any time. Cars will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense. Extra parking is available at Chemka Pool (there is a path that leads from the pool parking lot directly to Hillside School). In case of inclement weather pick up/drop off will take place inside. 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will be in the Big Gym and 4<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be in the Small Gym. If you pull into the circle, staff will be available to bring your child to their group or to go get them and bring your child to your car. If you are in the circle you may not leave your car. If you prefer, you may park in a spot in the lot and walk your child in or come get them.

Hastings Day Camp follows the same policy as Hillside Elementary School regarding all health policies. Due to the increase in food allergies sharing of food with any other campers is not permitted. We encourage parents to take time before camp starts to talk to their child regarding the issue of sharing any type of food with other campers.

## Below are suggestions and guidelines for what your child should bring to camp each day:

- A backpack
- A towel
- Snack and Lunch (use your own discretion when packing lunch because refrigeration is not available)
- Bathing suit (campers should come to camp with their bathing suit underneath their clothes to maximize swim time)
- Sunscreen
- Refillable water bottle

All campers' belongings should be **labeled with their full name.** Children MUST bring a note signed by a parent regarding any changes to their daily routine such as changes in pick-up.

<u>Below is a list of items that should NOT be brought to camp:</u> Camp is not responsible for any lost items. (All valuable belongings should be kept at home.)

-Pets (parents should refrain from bringing pets during drop off and pick up)
-Jewelry of any kind
-Money
-Electronic devices (such as I-pad's).
