CLIMATE SMART COMMUNITIES (CSC) SILVER CERTIFICATION & CLEAN ENERGY COMMUNITIES (CEC) ACHIEVEMENTS

- Silver Re-certification Approved for 69 action over the past year to help build towards a sustainable future for Hastings.
- Currently one of only eight silver-certified CSC communities, and one of 2 silver-level
 Villages in NY State.
- 440 CSC points now the highest number of points of any municipality in New York State.
- Top of the CEC leaderboard 5700 pts, 16 Actions completed + 2 Community Campaigns.

PE 3: DECREASE ENERGY USE

Policy Change

- Adopted Fleet Efficiency Policy.
- Added Energy Efficiency Provision in Village Landscaping Contract.

On the Ground Change

- Invested in energy efficient LEDs.
- Continued to purchase electric vehicles for Police and Village staff.

- Created baseline GHG inventory for the Community to track and measure progress.
- Updated Fleet Inventory and tracking in line with our Green Vehicle Strategy.

PE 5: CLIMATE SMART MATERIALS MANAGEMENT

Policy Change

- Joined EPA Wastewise Program.
- Adopted Organics Management Plan first CSC approved plan in NY State.

On the Ground Change

- Held several Repair Cafes.
- Improved the Food waste drop-off DPW site @12 Southside Ave, and Residential Organic Waste Program: curbside pick-up food waste collection program through Hudson Compost.

- Updated the recycling and Repair Café sections of Village Web site, and to Recycle Right app.
- Captured relevant data and set annual goals as part of Wastewise Program.

PE 6: CLIMATE SMART LAND USE

Policy Change

- Adopted Village-wide Master Bike Plan.
- Made improvements to the Natural Resources Inventory.

On the Ground Change

- Planned and undertook large Scale Tree Planting Project.
- Conducted a tree canopy inventory.
- Built alternative fuel infrastructure (two-port Level 2 chargers).

- Park dedication to increase protection for Natural Areas in perpetuity.
- Planted trees in Saw Mill River Watershed, Quarry Park, and Hillside Woods.

PE 7: COMMUNITY RESILIENCY TO CLIMATE CHANGE

Policy Change

- Created a Climate Adaptation and Resilience Vision.
- Evaluated Policies for Climate Resilience.

On the Ground Change

- Updated and promoted Cooling Centers.
- Held Water Week educational webinars.

- Completed a riperian area assessment and water smart landscaping.
- Updated Village web site with information on water conservation and reuse.

PE 8 & 11: GREEN INNOVATION

Policy Change

- Adopted Green Procurement Policy and Low-Embodied Carbon Concrete Policy.
- Completed Grid Rewards, Demand Response and Community Solar Campaigns / Competitions with other Rivertowns.

On the Ground Change

• Used low-embodied carbon concrete in several Village projects.

Institutionalize Change

• Hosted webinars to educate neighboring municipalities and other stakeholders on low-embodied carbon concrete.
