

## **Notes of Meeting, Conservation Commission 10/10/17**

- **Hillside Woods fence** – Parks and Rec. will lead in getting costs and other research; CC will support as needed; process will proceed to gain public support

- **Note-taking** - RFC will do for another two months, convert past session to typed text

- **Textile Recycling** - J. Hamerman is championing, reported progress in defining value proposition, clarifying final fate of clothes, shoes, bedding, towels, etc. contributed; aim to set up bin in HoH; organization will pay \$200 / ton for mixed textile discards

- **Rt. 9** - A. Ratzkin reported; next phase is conceptual planning of “complete streets” – e.g., not just bike paths, but also pinch points, pedestrian safety, bus service, etc.

- **Carbon Tax** - A. Ratzkin reported, tax will affect fuel costs - Transportation, Electric, Home Heating
