RESOLUTION

On motion of Trustee Armacost, seconded by Trustee Lopez the following Resolution was duly adopted upon roll call vote:

52:17 PARIS ACCORD RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, there is scientific consensus regarding the reality of climate change and the recognition that human activity, especially the combustion of fossil fuels that create greenhouse gases, is an important driver of climate change; and
- WHEREAS, 195 countries, including the United States, vowed to address climate change in agreements reached in Paris in December 2015 (the "Paris Agreement"); and
- WHEREAS, the White House announced on Thursday, June 1, 2017, its decision to withdraw the US from the Paris Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, this action by the Federal Government, abandoning national leadership on addressing the global crisis of climate change, leaves that responsibility to states, municipalities, businesses, institutions and individuals; and
- WHEREAS, the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson has a long-standing commitment through its Comprehensive Plan and Sustainability Action Plan to reduce its greenhouse gas emissions and to take all possible measures to reduce its contribution to human-caused climate change; and
- WHEREAS, the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson was recently designated a New York Clean Energy Community and has committed to further initiatives to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and
- WHEREAS, we are joined in taking action on climate change by a global coalition of cities, state and national governments and community and private sector leaders who recognize the importance and potential of these actions to protect and enhance the well-being of current and future generations; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED,** that the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson opposes the Federal Government's intent to withdraw the US from the Paris Climate Accord; and be it further

- **RESOLVED,** that the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson joins with over 240 US Climate Mayors and their municipalities representing over 56 million Americans, in adopting, honoring, and upholding the commitments to the goals enshrined in the Paris Agreement to meet the target of 1.5 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels, and to create a 21st century clean energy economy; and be it further
- **RESOLVED**, that all Village departments, boards and commissions shall, with the assistance of the Conservation Commission whenever appropriate, work to intensify our joint efforts to carry out the Village's Plans for reducing GHG emissions and thereby do our part to meet the Paris Agreement's targets.
