- Superintendent's report

Camp and pool permit registrations brought in over \$462k to date.

Chemka Pool is filled, staff in place, bath house being painted, sidewalk is striped, and we'll be supplying weekly water samples for the Spray Pool to WDoH.

Final version of parks signage approved and off to printer.

- Parks - status / updates

Uniontown - damage incurred to backstop, fencing, and dugout due to a tree that fell. We'll bring in Community Tree, an arborist or the Tree Board to give an evaluation of the trees. HLL president is working with the Village Manager regarding the insurance claim. Noted that any replacement dugout should match the quality of what was in place. Gene asked Aaron to note that the roots of the 2 locust trees by the batting cage/basketball court currently have root systems that run under the blacktop. HLL had concerns with the walkway leading up to the

bleachers, so with Village permission installed a hand rail.

Skate Park - Mike will follow up with Maureen Caraballo.

Dog Park - at the recent Trustee meeting, the Mayor asked that we ensure all stake holders are aware that the 9a parcel is being considered and she will reach out to Ginsburg.

Riverview Park fence is being replaced this week.

Quarry Park coming along nicely and fill will arrive within the next 2 weeks.

Bocce Court cannot be installed this spring due to the high demands on the parks crew to get the pool up and running, fields ready for play/programming, etc.

- Parks & Rec Dept - anticipated future capital needs

Added to the list of anticipated future capital needs:

MacEachron and Kinnally Cove - erosion.

Reynolds Park - water fountain, gate latch, pathway repair.
