1. Stop Signs at Yale/Warren and Yale/Amherst
Council members discussed the safety of placing more stop signs on a short street. It has been decided that two (2) stop signs will be added in both directions on Yale and none on Warren and Amherst.
2. Improving Crosswalk Safety at the County Trail-Way Crossing/Farragut Avenue
Council members received a request from a resident to add more signage to the crosswalk as it is dangerous to cross when cars are driving off Saw Mill Parkway. It was determined that Farragut Avenue off the Parkway is the State's jurisdiction and the crosswalk is the County's jurisdiction, therefore, they maintain the crosswalk and the signs. Chief will write to the resident and explain.

A vote was required for the position of Chairperson. A motion was made by Chief Vasilli in favor of Greg Bassman and seconded by Michael Gunther. The vote was unanimous.
