Site: One South Broadway, Hastings-on-Hudson, New York

Dear Mayor Armacost and Members of the Village Board of Trustees:

On behalf of Electric Owl Holdings, LLC (the "Applicant"), we respectfully submit this letter in furtherance of the pending Application and to supplement the most recent letters submitted by Cuddy & Feder LLP on behalf of Electric Owl Holdings, LLC (the "Supplemental Letters") on November 22, November 30, December 4, and December 12, 2023. This letter clarifies and expands upon the letter submitted yesterday regarding the previously described sidewalk improvements along South Broadway.

Having reviewed the frontage along South Broadway, noting the lack of sidewalks north of the Site as Broadway continues to the Church driveway, the Applicant has evaluated the feasibility of installing a sidewalk extending approximately 585 linear feet along the westerly side of South Broadway beyond the northerly boundary of the Site and continuing to the Church driveway. Along that approximately 600-foot distance there are points where the ground is either not level or is narrower than would accommodate a 5-foot-wide sidewalk. Where the adjacent grade is steep along property owned by neighbors' consent may be needed to construct retaining walls, which will increase the cost of installing the sidewalk. Nevertheless, as a community benefit to the Village, where possible, the Applicant is committed to constructing a 5-foot-wide sidewalk.

Please note that the Applicant does not anticipate or project any pedestrian traffic related to this project using the segment of South Broadway northerly of the Site, nor southerly of the Site between the bus stop and Dudley Street. Nevertheless, the Applicant recognizes the community benefit to providing pedestrian sidewalks along this area of South Broadway and is willing to

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construct this improvement for the Village that comprises approximately 950 linear feet of new sidewalk (not counting the 100-foot plus segment in the City of Yonkers).

Notably, the segment of the sidewalk that would extend southerly of the bus stop primarily is situated in the City of Yonkers. Accordingly, we respectfully confirm that the Applicant is willing to install a sidewalk in that area along South Broadway, if the Village requests it and, further, if it is permitted by whatever governmental agency or agencies have authority for approval thereof.

We respectfully request that this letter and its enclosures be incorporated in the official record of proceedings before the Board of Trustees.
