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Notice of an election to determine whether the village of Hastings on Hudson should become an incorporated village by the name of Hastings on Hudson having been duly published & posted in conformity with the provisions of an act or statute of the people of the State of New York, Entitled an act for the Incorporation of Villages passed April 20. 1870.

And all the requirements of said Statute having been duly complied with an election was held for such purpose at Protection Hall in said village of Hastings on Hudson on the 18th day of November 1879.

At which it appears by the certificate of the result of such election duly filed in the County Clerk's office of the County of Westchester made by Abram O. Wilera Supervisor of the Town of Greenburgh & Julian Verplank Town Clerk of said Town the inspectors holding & presiding at such election that the whole number of ballots cast were, One hundred & seventy nine of which One hundred & four were for incorporation & seventy five against incorporation.

The said inspectors in pursuance of said Statute having thereafter caused to be published & posted in due form of law notice of the time & place of an election for the first Village Officers such election for Village Officers was held in Protection Hall on the 2nd day of January A.S. 1880.
