Fingerprinting Instructions

As per Village Code 214-3, all Peddlers, Solicitors, and Vendors are required to be fingerprinted by the Hastings-on-Hudson Police Department.

The fee is \$20 payable to the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson and is to be paid at the Village Clerk's Office.

Appointments for fingerprinting are to be scheduled ahead of submitting your completed application. You may call the Police Department's non-emergency phone number at 914-478-2344, or visit the Police Department in-person to schedule an appointment for fingerprinting.

No permit may be issued without fingerprints on file.
