

Message from the Mayor: Waterfront meeting this Wednesday 7:30 Community Center

Fellow Residents;

A reminder that the Village will be holding two back-to-back public hearings this Wednesday, February 3rd, from 7:30PM onwards at the Community Center.

The first is a public hearing to take public input on the demolition permit that BP Arco has applied for to bring down the remaining large structure, "Building 52", on the waterfront. That document is available [here](#) - it is quite large and so a physical copy is also available in the library.

Once this hearing is complete, there will be a second public session where people can comment on the Consent Decree. It can be found [here](#) and a physical copy available at the library. This agreement has been negotiated by the Village, Riverkeeper and BP Arco and is before the Board of Trustees for their approval before it is signed.
