Michael Schlacter, Gene Calamari & Larry young, all residents of Cedar Street, attended the meeting to share their concerns over speeding and reckless driving. Of the extensive letter Mr. Schlacter sent to The Board of Trustees and The Transportation Working Group, recommendations include:

- Speed reducing signage
- Lowering the speed limit to 10mph
- A stop sign at the north end of Cedar St.
- A stop sign at the top of the steep hill portion of Cedar St.
- Traction devices on the hill portion of Cedar St.
- Sidewalk
- Rumble Strips (Mr. Schlacter volunteered to have them installed in front of his home)
  
- These residents also requested that the same measures above be taken on Hudson Street with the addition of a crosswalk across High Street at Hudson Street.

There was a review of the meeting between The Safety Council and The Transportation Working Group.

- Our comprehensive list of current crosswalks in need of reflective paint has been sent to Greenburgh.

Richard and Dan are going to rework our comprehensive list of new crosswalks by zone. As there are a few crosswalks that could prove counterintuitive, Richard will then send to engineer to see what falls under their current study in hopes they can analyze.

Trustee Lopez proposed reaching out to Lisa Litvin to organize a meet and greet between the PTSA and TWG.
