Discussed possible future steps for the committee.

County Paving on Warburton

Discussed how suggestions on striping will be incorporated by the county.

Farragut Ave. & School

Trustee Lopez informed us that after a Farragut and High Street incident on January 8th, Legislator MaryJane Shimsky highlighted that she would like that particular intersection reviewed. This has prompted a meeting with NYS DOT, county, town and village officials to discuss this location, but also put other locations around Hastings on the table for immediate attention. The meeting may take place in late February or early March.

- Richard suggested we review map of accidents the TWG has mapped, to help inform.

Update from Trustee Lopez on Engineers' Report and Other Discussions

- Information regarding size of vehicles has been forwarded from village to firm (Sam Schwartz).
- Village is looking at enlarging study to include more work on Cedar Street and James Street, and Rt. 9 improvements and streets affected.
- Trustee Lopez is starting to work with Village technology (Rafael Zaratzian) to centralize a way to respond to people who have comments about transportation issues.
- Trustee Lopez asked for a list of the suggestions that have been put in front of the BoT over the past two years. TWG to provide.
- Matt gave an update on school zone signage and related speed limits.
- Discussed getting together with school board and PTSA and Sam Schwartz to discuss next steps.
