LOCAL LAW 5 OF 2019

A LOCAL LAW Amending Chapter 184 Licenses and Permits to Rename the Chapter, Delete Items Included in Other Code Provisions and Amend Provisions for Permits for Parades and Gatherings

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 184, Licenses and Permits, of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Chapter 184 - Permits for Parades and Gatherings

§ 184-1. Permit required.

Any individual or organization causing a congregation of people at any public place within the Village or wishing to participate in or conduct any organized parade or procession, other than a funeral procession, on the public streets, sidewalks, or other public property in the Village shall first file a permit application with the Village Clerk and pay the appropriate fee.

§ 184-2. Fees.

The fee for such permit shall be set by the Board of Trustees by resolution and set forth in the fee schedule.

§ 184-3. Penalties for offenses.

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be punished subject to the penalties prescribed by §1-13 of the Village Code.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
