Hello Mr. Frobel,

This is George Farrell, Commodore of the Tower Ridge Yacht Club, 1 River Street, Hasting-on-Hudson. I was advised that the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is possibly looking for a storage area to store the Anaconda Wire and Cable Water Tower.

The membership at the Tower Ridge Yacht Club would like to be considered for this storage project. The Tower Ridge in my opinion would be the most convenient place to store this "Piece of History" as we have been in the Village since 1889 and have no plans on leaving or closing the Tower Ridge Yacht Club. Therefore, the Tower Ridge Yacht Club could actually guarantee a storage place for any amount of time that is necessary for the Village to store this Tower.

The Tower Ridge Yacht Club would ask the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson to pay a monthly rate of one thousand five hundred dollars a month (\$1,500.00) for a term to be determined. If this offer is to be approved by the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson the Board of Trustees of the Tower Ridge Yacht Club would like to meet up with the construction company in charge of dismantling of the Water Tower just to verify that the Tower Ridge Yacht Club is 100 percent capable of being able to store this piece of history.
