On behalf of ExxonMobil Environmental Services Co. and in accordance with your request forwarded by Jeremiah Quinlan, Woodard & Curran is providing the attached topographical survey done in 2011 for lands now or formerly of Mobil Oil Corporation (now ExxonMobil Oil Corporation).

Per project documents, the eastern property (now or formerly of Paul Uhlich & Co. Inc.) and the subject property share an agreement and easements associated with access to Zinsser Bridge (currently closed to vehicular traffic) and existing utilities. The Village of Hastings-on-Hudson also has an easement along the north property boundary for a storm sewer.

As the Village is aware, the terminal is no longer in operation and the property has been a vacant lot since the mid 1980's. Remaining known structures, including foundations and pads, are shown on the enclosed survey. There are no known underground active utilities with the exception of a 42" pipe that was encountered during field work in 2010. The section of the pipe that was encountered is shown on the enclosed survey in the north central portion of the property. Though not able to be confirmed by Village records, the pipe is presumed to be a storm sewer.
